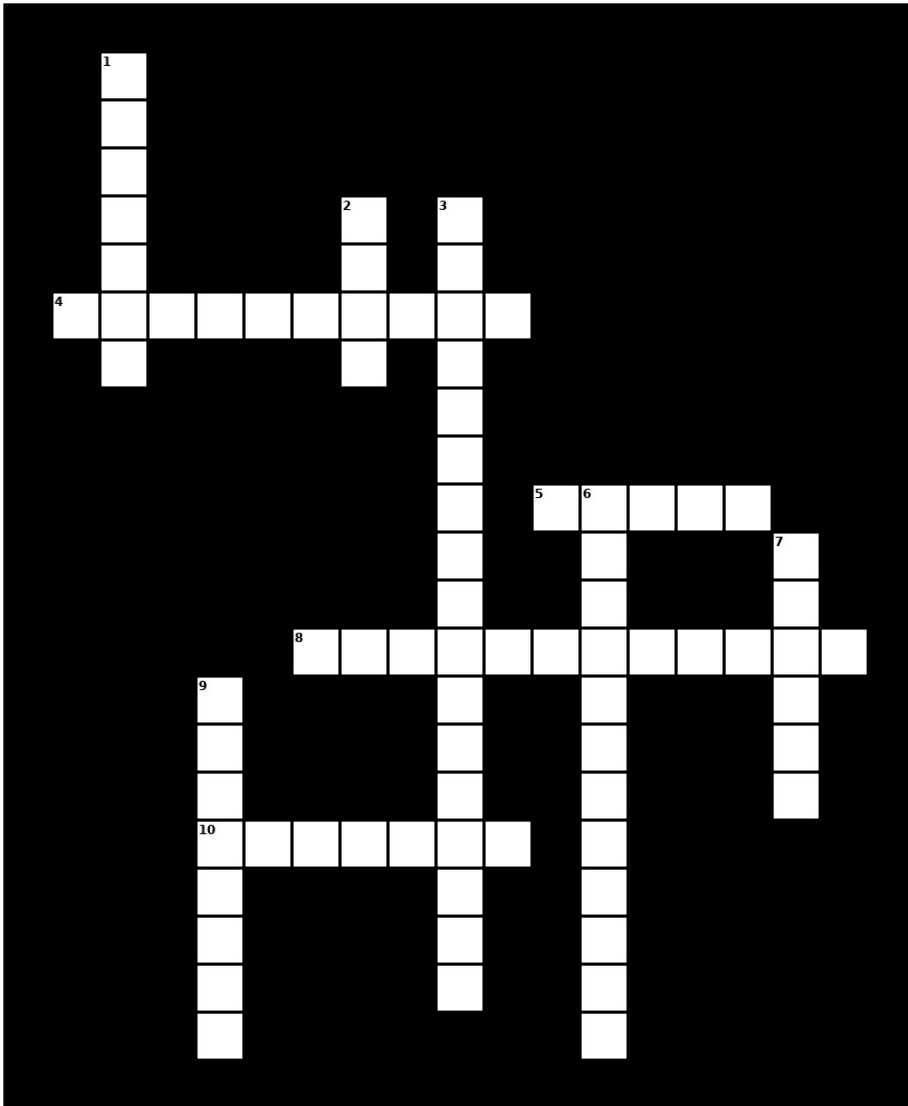


1.4 Network security - Crossword 1: Threats and attacks
