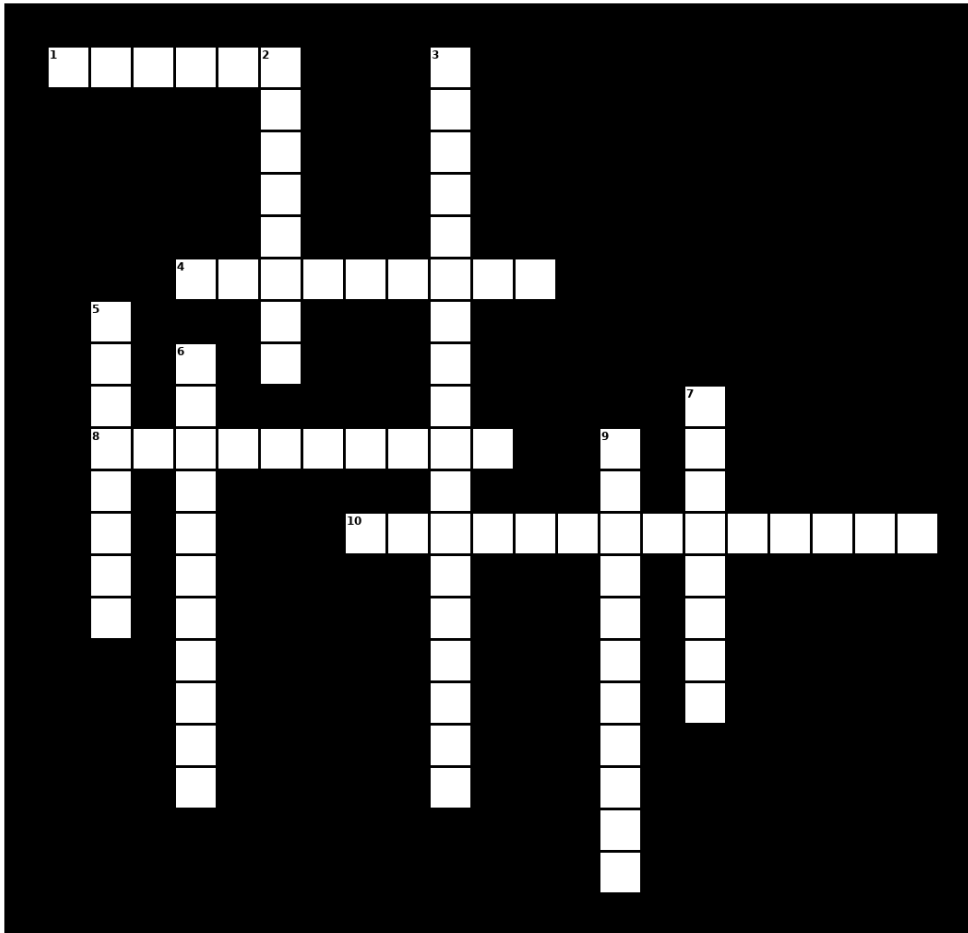


1.4 Network security - Crossword 2: Protection methods
