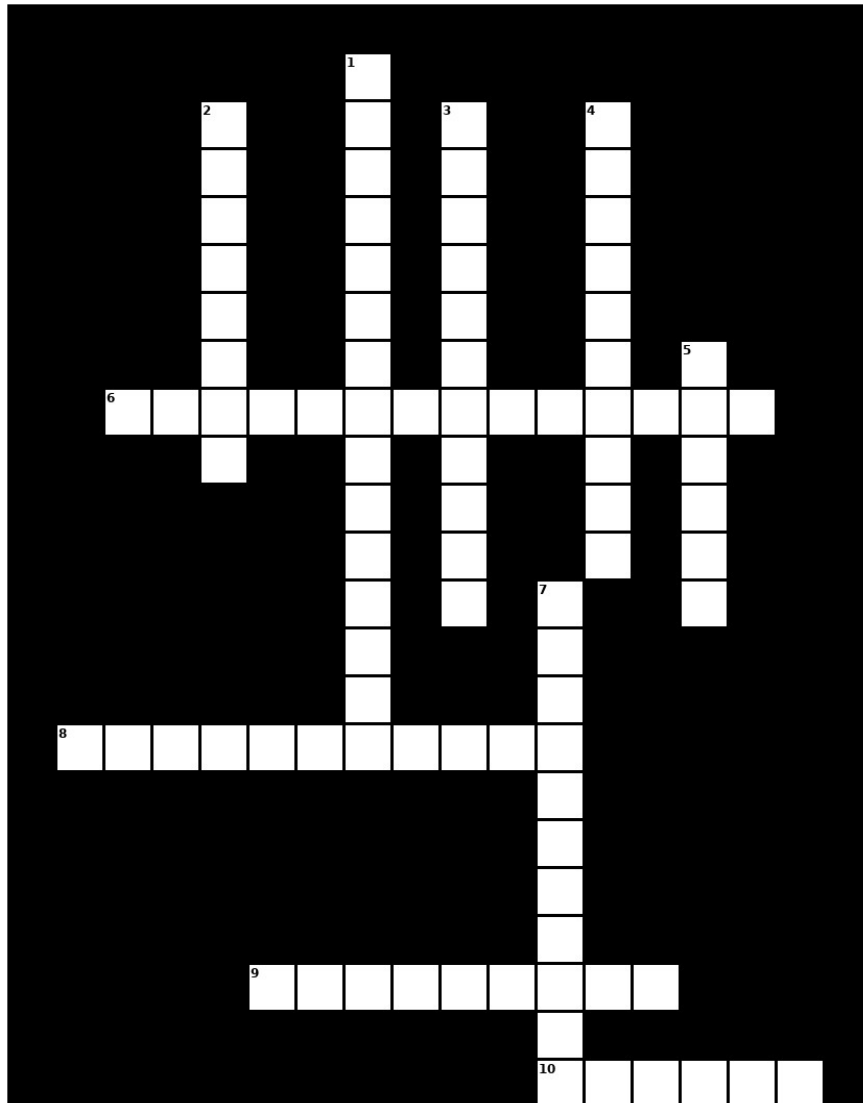


2.3 Producing robust programs - Crossword 2: Robust design
